 1/2 cup margarine or butter
 2 cups half-and-half

Butter square pan, 8x8x2 inches. Spread nuts in pan. Heat sugar, corn syrup, margarine and 1 cup of the half-and-half to boiling in 3-quart saucepan over medium heat, stirring constantly. Stir in remaining half-and-half. Cook over medium heat, stirring frequently, to 245° on candy thermometer or until small amount of mixture dropped into very cold water forms a firm ball. Immediately spread over nuts in pan. Cool; cut into about 1-inch squares. 3 DOZEN CANDIES.

Chocolate Caramels: Heat 2 squares (1 ounce each) unsweetened chocolate with the sugar.

Cougar Conservancy

I couldn't imagine a California without cougars. As a golden state native it was an honor to co-lead efforts to list Southern and Central Coast mountain lions under the California Endangered Species Act. And in 2020, these imperiled populations were granted temporary protection including our very own P-22. The Cougar Conservancy launched just as these select cougar populations became a candidate species.

Our mission is to reduce human-wildlife conflict and conserve cougar populations through science-based management and conservation. The Cougar Conservancy assists communities in coexisting with cougars through education, outreach, and conflict management. We support communities in the neighborhoods and foothills on both sides of the proposed 101 Wildlife Crossing in living alongside these incredible big cats. We believe that it is crucial to identify conflicts in these small, isolated populations and address them in a way that saves cougars, domestic animals, and human livelihoods.

The Cougar Conservancy's Conflict Task Force works on the ground to prevent conflicts before they occur, directly intervene when a cougar's life is on the line, and empower local communities through training, education, and technical assistance. If a resident has unprotected pets or livestock in cougar habitat, we assist them in building secure enclosures to house their animals in at night, at no cost or through a cost-share program. Our Conflict Hotline is also a resource for California residents. You can call and report a sighting, request information, or schedule a presentation for your community. Please visit our web page to learn more.

Conserving cougars is possible, even in a megacity such as Los Angeles. Their conservation will require strategies to promote coexistence between people and cougars, preservation of habitat capable of sustaining large carnivores, as well as connectivity between those habitats.
