

29 Sept Thurs 98 miles visit International UFO Museum, Research Center & Gift Shop Roswell, Walmart Supercenter supplies, Penny's Diner, Vaughn NM for lunch, arrive ABQ Balloon Fiesta campground 30 Sept Fri - 02 Oct Sun 306 miles to Loretto Chapel, Santa Fe NM, then Morefield Campground, Mesa Verde National Park, CO


03-04 Mon-Tues explore Mesa Verde - Far View Lodge

Paul also recommends the story Tracks: A Woman's 1700 Miles of Australia. I now have Kindle on my MM-K8


Lunch at vegetarian place was Great. Wendy knows her spices.





Walmart in Roswell for supplies. Vege, milk, replacement power cable from the fused loaner cord from PaulO.


Visited the International UFO Museum and Research Center - 114 N Main St, Roswell NM 88203

Mon 1st day driving tour of Mesa Verde -; Ranger ? Pete gave us great suggestion of what would be visible for me & my MS.


Great dinner at The Lounge - amazing to be able to see Mesa and the cracks, which my cam could zoom into & see structures.
